HALF-DAY COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT TOURS

Cape Town Society for the Blind (CTSB)

Visit the Cape Town Society for the Blind, a 90-year-old organization empowering visually impaired individuals through training, rehabilitation, and employment support. Learn how they help older persons live independently through skills development and social programs.

Intergenerational Dialogue and Storytelling Tour (District Six)

Discover the history of District Six, once a vibrant, diverse community destroyed under Apartheid. Over 60,000 residents were forcibly removed, and their homes demolished. This visit includes an intergenerational dialogue on resilience and heritage, elder-led storytelling on forced removals, and powerful musical and spoken word performances.

FULL-DAY COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT TOURS

Neighbourhood Old Age Homes (NOHA)

Explore NOAH's innovative approach to ageing through affordable communal housing and social enterprises run by older adults. Learn how their integrated model supports dignity, independence, and community for vulnerable older persons.

Golden Oldies Senior Centre, Hout Bay

Hangberg Dreams NPC supports vulnerable seniors through home visits, outreach, and joyful community events. Meet a vibrant group of older persons who will share stories of history, resilience, and cultural heritage. The day ends with a scenic Hout Bay tour, a Seal Island Cruise (weather permitting), and a visit to the penguins at Boulders Beach.

Val de VieRetirement Estate, Paarl Valley

Visit Val de Vie Evergreen, South Africa's safest retirement village, known for its secure, community-focused living and stunning natural surroundings. Explore the estate's amenities, from wine cellars to walking trails. The day continues with a scenic winelands tour, featuring two wine tastings, a cellar tour, and cheese pairing.
